2 - FACE MASKS ARE MANDATORY! Please bring your own mask on Sunday services. We also remind everyone that the congregation is NOT supposed to sing along with the soloist(s) for the time being, unfortunately!

3 - BIG THANK YOU! I have started this new session because it is in my heart to thank those who use their talents, time and treasures to keep our congregation going. Today I thank **Lori Salter**. She has been a big support in the fellowship department of our church, always ready to help in preparing and serving meals for potlucks, winkels, bible studies and many other social gatherings. 5 - PRIVATE COMMUNION: If you wish to have a private communion because you still don't feel safe coming to church on Sundays, please call our office and make an appointment with Andrea. You will meet me in the church sanctuary and we will follow all health and safety protocols. Please bring a plate and a cup of your own.

6 – OUR PIPE ORGAN: We are thankful to our God that we can hear the “joyful sound” of our organ again! Jason Barnsley, the person in charge of restoring our precious centennial pipe organ is still working on some little things to make it work perfectly. It is taking him much more time and energy than he expected, but

he is asking us all to be PATIENT with him as he tries to finish his work. We thank all members who generously donated to the organ fund so that we could revive this instrument again for the glory of God!

7 - NEWS FROM THE CALGARY CIRCUIT: Rev. Timothy Graff will be installed as the new pastor for Redeemer Lutheran Church, Didsbury on this coming Sunday, October 4. Unfortunately it is not possible to have a large attendance from the circuit due to COVID. We pray for God's blessings for Redeemer and Pastor Graff as they begin their mutual service to the Lord and His church in the coming days.

8 – SMLC FOOD CUPBOARD: Our food cupboard is well stocked and we would like to extend our help to any congregation member or someone they know that might be in need during these difficult times.
