Hello dear SMLC Family and friends!

1 - WE ARE OPEN FOR WORSHIP! If you plan to come for worship this Sunday and you haven't come since we re-opened our doors, please don't forget to sign up with Andrea. Remember to call our office BEFORE it closes for the week by Thursday at 3 pm. If you are already coming regularly, you are automatically on the list and you don't need to call the office anymore. IF you are on the list and are NOT coming, we encourage you to call the office and let Andrea know. We will continue to follow all health and safety protocols. See you hopefully on Sunday!

2 - FACE MASKS ARE MANDATORY! Please bring your own mask on Sunday services. We also remind everyone that the congregation is NOT supposed to sing along with the soloist(s) for the time being, unfortunately!

3 - HOLY COMMUNION: After careful and prayerful consideration, we have now decided to start offering communion following some special health and safety protocols. Please read our new procedures for communion in our website. We highly recommend that families use a common plate or tray for the bread and even a common cup for the whole family. Next communion service is **October 18**.

4 - PRIVATE COMMUNION: If you wish to have a private communion because you still don't feel safe coming to church on Sundays, please call our office and make an appointment with Andrea. You will meet me in the church sanctuary, and we

will follow all health and safety protocols. Please bring a plate and a cup of your own.

5 – SMLC FOOD CUPBOARD: Our food cupboard is well stocked and we would like to extend our help to any congregation member or someone they know that might be in need during these difficult times. 6 - RENTAL REVIEW COMMITTEE: Presently, St. Matthew Lutheran Church rents the parsonage, the sanctuary and basement and parking lot spots. To review and implement current rental policies and oversee renters, we are seeking volunteers to join the committee. The service provided by the committee is vital to our congregation, since it directly supports our mission and ministry. As of October, we will be offering online bible study over zoom every Wednesday, at 7 p.m., except when there is a fifth Wednesday (that one will be free). I will lead the study called: “Who are we, Lutherans”? every second and fourth Wednesday. We will send out the password to log in to zoom meeting on those days. 8 – BOARD OF EVANGELISM: Lorraine Duncan has requested to return to the board after taking some “time off” and is now our representative of this important board. Lorraine will be installed (blessed) on Thanksgiving Sunday, October 11 on both services. Welcome to our PPC Lorraine!

9 – SOLOISTS: we know that we are NOT supposed to sing along in church, so we use soloists, members who volunteer to sing the hymns during service. If you think you may help us out by singing as well, let us know. We are searching for “hidden talents” out there!
